The fellowships are intended for scientists who wish to carry out research in fields represented at Nordita. Candidates working in other areas will be considered when it is scientifically justified. Since female scientists are underrepresented at Nordita we especially encourage women to apply.

All applications for the Nordita fellowships will be reviewed in the beginning of December, and the first offers should be sent out before the end of the year.

Nordita is jointly hosted by Stockholm University and KTH Royal Institute of Technology. Research at Nordita covers a wide range of modern theoretical physics including *astrophysics, biological physics, condensed matter physics, gravitation, cosmology and astroparticle physics, high-energy physics, and statistical physics/complex systems.* The research activity of the local academic staff is supplemented by *Nordita Scientific Programs,* which bring together groups of leading experts to work on specific topics for extended periods. There is also ample opportunity for collaboration with faculty and research staff at local universities.
